

2023 TBA GNOT Qualifying

The 2023 TBA GNOT Qualifying events are being conducted over 6 walk-in sessions (in two streams of 3 sessions), scored by cross-imps.

- 1) 3 Friday morning sessions from 18th August
- 2) 3 Monday evening sessions from 14th August

Qualification to Southern Tasmania GNOT Regional Final

Any pair (either home or away members) that plays in at **least 2 qualifying sessions** in a single qualifying stream will be eligible to form a team with other pair(s) who have similarly played in at least 2 qualifying sessions to represent the TBA in the Regional Final, to be held as a one day event on Sunday 24th September. The number of teams that the TBA is permitted to send to the Regional Final is dependent on the total number of qualifying pairs.

A list of qualifying pairs will be posted both on the noticeboard at the TBA and on the TBA Website under results, GNOT Night Qualifying & GNOT Daytime Qualifying. Pairs will be ranked by their best 2 session scores.

Teams of 4⁽¹⁾ are encouraged to enter the Southern Regional Final as soon as possible after the qualification sessions have ended. The event will be available for self booking on MyABF. Players may alternatively email their entry to tba@tasbridge.com.au or ask a director at one of TBA sessions to book them in. Table money will be levied at \$80 per team for the GNOT Regional Final. Entries will close 1pm on Friday 22nd September.

If the number of teams wishing to play is greater than the number of permitted teams, the teams to be excluded will be the teams that contain the lowest combined rank of the qualifying pairs.

(1) Teams of 5 or 6 may play in the GNOT Final, however, airfare subsidies paid by the ABF are restricted to 4 persons
